3. the RIGHTS of conscience and religious liberty.

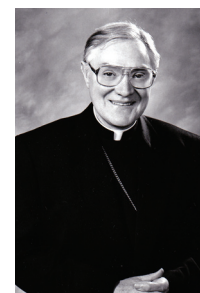
